## STANDS FOR

- 1. Retaliation against those nations which shut out our goods.
- 2. Free raw materials.
- 3. Discouragement by a small tariff of the import from protected countries of those manufactures which we can ourselves produce.
- 4. Consequent encouragement of our own workers who are at present continually deprived of their legitimate employment by the unfair import of foreign of foreign manufactures, produced often by sweated and underpaid labour.
- 5. Preference for the Colonies where it can be given without hurt to ourselves in return for a reciprocal preference to us.
- 6. A change of the present taxation of food, so that it be shifted from such foreign imports as we do not ourselves produce, such as sugar, tea, &c., to those foreign imports which we do produce as wheat, meat and dairy produce. In this manner, without increasing by a farthing our cost of living, we may assure a safe market for our own farmers and our Colonial kinsmen.
- 7. The re-peopling of the agricultural districts which would be much assisted by the above.
- 8. One Parliament for the United Kingdom.
- 9. A sane broad-minded and liberal treatment of all questions of domestic concern.
- 10. Increased economy in the national finances, together with the highest efficiency in the public services.
